**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO RESCHEDULE AMEREN MISSOURI
WITNESS AND NOTICE THAT EVIDENTIARY HEARING WILL START
APRIL 12, 2024**

The Commission set a one-week evidentiary hearing for April 15-19, 2024. On March 27, 2024, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed a motion requesting that the Commission allow cross-examination of its witness, Jeffery Holmstead, to occur on April 12, 2024, prior to the rest of the hearing. Jeffrey Holmstead is unavailable to testify during the week of April 15, 2024.

Ameren Missouri represents that it has contacted all other parties and that there is no objection to Jeffrey Holmstead’s testimony occurring on April 12, 2024. Therefore, the Commission will grant Ameren Missouri’s request.

Granting Ameren Missouri’s motion changes the start date of the evidentiary hearing to April 12, 2024. Accordingly, the Commission is providing notice that the evidentiary hearing in this matter will begin April 12, 2024, with the testimony of Jeffrey Holmstead.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Ameren Missouri's motion to have Jeffrey Holmstead testify on April 12, 2024, is granted.

2. The evidentiary hearing is scheduled to begin April 12, 2024, at 9:00 a.m. The April 12, 2024, portion of the hearing will be held virtually by telephone and videoconference via WebEx. The WebEx meeting number is 2632 941 9547. The telephone number to participate is 1-650-479-3207, and the password to attend is 0021. The rest of the evidentiary hearing is unchanged and is scheduled for April 15-19, 2024, in room 310 of the Governor Office Building starting at 9:00 a.m. or as ordered by the Regulatory Law Judge. 3. This order is effective when issued.
