COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff"), by and through counsel, and for its *Notice of Correction to Staff Report*, respectfully states:

- 1. On April 1, 2024, Staff filed its *Staff Report* ("Report") in this matter.
- 2. Prior to filing its report, Staff spoke with personnel from Empire District Electric Company d/b/a Liberty ("Liberty") on March 28, 2024 regarding the throughput disincentive ("TD").
- 3. Table 1 on page 3 of Staff's Report incorrectly included TD values from before the March 28, 2024 conversations. These changes are incorporated into the attached Appendix A, the *Corrected Staff Report*.
- 4. In addition to the changes regarding the TD values, the Total Programs

 Cost Variance at the top of Table 1 is an over collection, not under collection as labeled in the original Report.
- 5. These corrections do not affect Staff's ultimate conclusion that no incidence or evidence of imprudence have been identified at this time for the Review Period.¹
