ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE, ADDING PARTIES, AND DIRECTING RESPONSES TO APPLICATION

On March 18, 2024, Sullivan Development Properties, LLC filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission requesting a change of electric supplier from Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri to Farmington, Missouri City Light and Water.

The Commission will direct its Data Center to send notice of the application to Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri and Farmington, Missouri City Light and Water. Because they are necessary parties, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri and Farmington, Missouri City Light and Water will be joined as parties to this proceeding and will be directed to file responses to the application.

The Commission will direct the Staff of the Commission (Staff) to file a recommendation.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Data Center shall send this order, with a copy of the application, to Union Electric d/b/a Ameren Missouri and Farmington, Missouri City Light and Water.

2. Union Electric d/b/a Ameren Missouri and Farmington, Missouri City Light and Water are made parties to this proceeding and shall each file response to the application no later than May 3, 2024.

3. Staff shall file its recommendation, or a request for an extension of time stating when it expects to file its recommendation, no later than May 23, 2024.

4. This order shall be effective when issued.

3. Applicant requests the Missouri Public Service Commission to order a change of electric supplier to the address indicated above.



5. Applicant requests the Missouri Public Service Commission to order a change of electric provider for the following reasons. * Current provider cannot provide service to address for a reasonable cost. The current provider has stated it would cost a few hundred thousand dollars to get service to the property. The property the service change is being requested for is a residential property. Requested provider has established service roughly 60 feet away and is willing to serve the location.

6. Applicant has taken the following steps in an attempt to work out electric service problems with the electric service provider: Contacted current provider multiple times to establish service and they refused. Also current provider refuses to give permission to applicant to allow Farmington City Light and Water to provide service.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests the Missouri Public Service Commission to issue an Order which changes the current electric service provider.



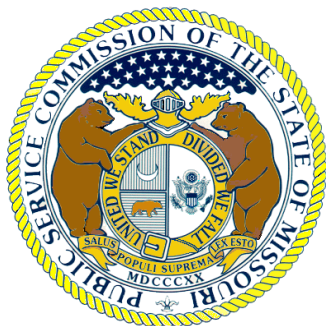
