## ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION TO INTERVENE

Issue Date: April 5, 2024

On March 1, 2024,<sup>1</sup> Missouri-American Water Company (MAWC) filed a petition to change its water and sewer infrastructure rate adjustments (WSIRA). The Commission issued notice and set a deadline for applications to intervene.

On March 21, the Midwest Energy Consumers' Group (MECG) timely filed an application to intervene. MECG stated that it is an incorporated entity that represents the interests of large commercial and industrial users of water. MECG stated its interests are different than those of the general public. MECG stated that it has not yet taken a position on the application.

More than ten days have passed since the filing of MECG's application to intervene and no one has responded.<sup>2</sup> After considering the unopposed application to intervene, the Commission finds that MECG has interests which are different from that of the general public and could be affected by a final order. Therefore, in accordance with Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.075(3), the Commission will grant the application to intervene.
