I would refrain from closing out this matter. Thanks to the actions imposed by the Commission and ordering to show cause on the actions listed and this involves a forger document crafted by Ameren Missouri, I have taken the approach and hired legal counsel outside of this matter. My legal counsel filed a criminal complaint with the Federal Bureau Of Investigations Cybercrime and Network Security team, since the document in question was submitted through a government agency portal and through a digital IP address, in which we have turned the IP address used for the crafting of the document and the document itself over to the Cybercrimes unit.

Unfortunately in addition to me wanting several parties prosecuted for infringing my rights, but furthermore participating and involving themselves in crafting and producing a counterfeit document to defraud me and extort me out of money, the Commission needs to grant my Change of Supplier regardless.

Allowing a utility company to craft and use forgery documents to extort me out of \$ [REDACTED] doesn't allow them to participate as a utility provider and involves stern prosecution against those parties involved. I have also named the prior Regulatory Judge John Clark in the complaint as he is aware of the counterfeit document himself, along with other parties.

My Complaint isn't going away anytime soon, even if the Commission decides to dismiss my Complaint, all it is going to do is make my legal counsel seek stern prosecution against any and all Commissioners, Regulatory Judges, undersigned Counsel for Ameren Missouri, employees of Ameren Missouri who participated in the crafting and utilization of the document at question .
