PUBLIC COUNSEL'S PROPOSED CUSTOMER NOTICE

COMES NOW the Office of the Public Counsel and in response to the Commission's Order and Notice states as follows:

- 1. On September 5, 2008, Aquila, Inc., doing business as KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company filed a general rate increase case.
- 2. On September 12, the Commission issued its Order and Notice, which directed Public Counsel to submit a proposed local public hearing places and dates, and a proposed customer notice, no later than October 22. A number of the parties are still discussing a number of issues (the true-up date, testimony filing dates, etc.) that will have a bearing on the dates for local public hearings. Those discussions are unlikely to be completed by October 22, and Public Counsel anticipates that the parties will request additional time to file proposed procedural schedules.
- 3. Public Counsel submits the following draft customer notice in response to the Commission's September 12 order. Because the Commission has not yet set the dates, times, or locations for the local public hearing, there are necessarily some blanks in the proposed notice.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Aquila, Inc., doing business as KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company, has filed revised electric service tariff sheets with the Missouri Public Service Commission (PSC) which would increase the Company's Missouri jurisdictional annual gross revenues in its MPS service area by approximately \$66 million and in its L&P service area by approximately \$17 million. For the average MPS residential customer using 1,000 kilowatt hours of electricity, the proposed increase would be approximately \$12.50 each month. For the average L&P residential customer using 1,000 kilowatt hours of electricity, the proposed increase would be approximately \$10.00 each month. The proposed increase is approximately 14% in each of the Company's service territories.
