ORDER APPROVING QUARTERLY COST ADJUSTMENT TARIFF

Issue Date: May 13, 2024

Effective Date: June 1, 2024

On April 15, 2024, Evergy Missouri West, Inc. d/b/a Evergy Missouri West (EMW) filed a tariff sheet providing its current Quarterly Cost Adjustment (QCA). On May 7, 2024, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a Recommendation, stating that the Commission should approve the tariff.

In its verified recommendation, Staff states that it has reviewed the tariff sheet and the mathematical calculations provided by EMW. Staff is of the opinion that EMW has calculated the QCA for the first quarter of 2024 in accordance with the standards set forth in EMW's Tariff Sheet Nos. 6.6 through 6.10. Staff recommends the Commission approve the proposed tariff sheet.

Parties were given until May 10, 2024, to respond to Staff's recommendation. No party has objected or filed any response to either Staff's recommendation or EMW's pending tariff sheet.

EMW proposes a QCA Rate of \$0.4860 per Million British Thermal Unit (MMBtu), which is an increase over the currently effective QCA Rate of \$0.1615 per MMBtu. This proposed QCA Rate will apply during the first quarter of 2024, which is EMW's billing

period of June 1, 2024 through August 31, 2024. The previous three QCA Rates and Reconciliation Rates (R Factors), added to this proposed QCA Rate and R Factor, will result in an increase of a steam customer's bill of \$1,001.70 for every thousand MMBtu used during the fourth quarter of the 2023 billing period, compared to the fourth quarter of the 2023 billing period.

The Commission has reviewed EMW's tariff sheet and Staff's verified recommendation. Based on these filings, the Commission finds that the tariff sheet is in compliance with the Commission's previous orders and EMW's current tariff provisions.

The Commission approves the tariff sheet as ordered below. As the application and recommendation are unopposed, and so that this tariff may go into effect expeditiously on the requested effective date, the Commission will make this order effective in less than thirty days.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Tariff No. JH-2024-0148, submitted on April 15, 2024, is approved to become effective on June 1, 2024. The tariff sheet approved is:
