Dear Judge Dippell,

As part of the Stipulation and Agreement in case WR-2022-0303, approved by the Commission on May 3, 2023, MAWC is required to file a bi-annual Lead Service Line Report. The report includes the following:

- Known and estimated existing lead lines by source;
- Lines replaced each reporting period filing as well as cumulative total lines replaced to date;
- Location (zip code +4) and customer type of line replacement (e.g., residential, commercial, school, commercial, etc.);
- Average cost, and breakdown by company and customer side, per district for each reporting period;
- Nature and type of pipe replaced (e.g., lead, copper, galvanized gooseneck, etc.);
- Water sampling results.

The most recent Lead Service Line Report is included in this filing.

### **Previous Material**

All previous material is either lead or galvanized requiring replacement.

#### **Water Quality Results**

EPA'S Revised Lead & Copper Rule requires that utilities provide the customer with a Pitcher/Filter at time of replacement and sample 3-6 months later. To prepare for the future effective ruling date, Missouri American Water transitioned away from sampling at time of replacement on October 1, 2023. In addition, for the last 3 months, Missouri American Water has been ramping up the delivery of Pitcher/Filters and customers have responded positively.

Missouri American Water would like to propose providing the following information:

- Lead samples % exceedance vs % non-exceedance based on Action Level (current level, 15 ppm)
  - No exceedance to date (04/01)
- Locations that exceed Action Level (current level, 15 ppm)
  - No exceedance to date (04/01)
- From February End of March, only 72 samples kits received.
