1. On October 18, 2023, the Commission issued its *Order Approving Transfer of Assets and Granting Certificate of Convenience and Necessity* (“Order”) in this case. The *Order*, among other things, requires Confluence Rivers to “. . . file notice in this case outlining completion of the above recommended training, customer communications, notifications and billing within ten days after such communications and notifications[.]” (*Order*, p. 6, para. 3.m.).


