**NOTICE OF SUBMISSION OF ADDITIONAL INFORMATION
REQUESTED BY THE COMMISSION'S STAFF**

COMES NOW Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Company" or "Ameren Missouri"), and hereby gives notice that it is submitting additional information requested informally by the Staff, as follows:

1. Exhibit B to the Stipulation and Agreement ("Stipulation") approved by the Commission in its *Order Approving Stipulation and Agreement and Granting Certificates of Convenience and Necessity* ("Order") issued in this docket is a workpaper showing the Renewable Resource Rates and Renewable Benefits Rates over the 15-year subscription period using a starting Renewable Resource Rate of \$9.50 per kilowatt and a starting Renewable Benefits Rate of \$.04 per kilowatt-hour.

2. As indicated in the Company's May 16, 2024, Notice, the auction cleared at a higher Renewable Resource Rate, which will result in higher Renewable Resource Rates for years two through 15 of the subscribers' subscription. The Renewable Benefits Rates applicable to subscribers for each year of the 15-year subscription period remain as indicated on Exhibit B to the Stipulation.

3. Attached hereto as Schedule 1 is an updated Exhibit B which reflects the Renewable Resource Rates and Renewable Benefit Rates for all 15 years of the subscriptions, using the higher auction-cleared first year Renewable Resource Rate and the unchanged first year Renewable Benefits Rate to derive the year two through 15 rates.

WHEREFORE, Ameren Missouri submits the updated Exhibit B as requested by the Staff.
