**MOTION OF PETER MEIER AND EMILY MEDLYN TO APPEAR AND
PARTICIPATE *PRO HAC VICE***

Peter Meier and Emily Medlyn, pursuant to 20 CSR 4240-2.040 and Missouri Supreme Court Rules 6.01(m) and 9.03, hereby petition the Public Service Commission of the State of Missouri (the Commission) for leave to be permitted to appear and participate in the above-captioned proceeding. In support of this Motion to Appear and Participate *Pro Hac Vice*, Mr. Meier and Ms. Medlyn respectfully state as follows:

1. Mr. Meier and Ms. Medlyn are attorneys in the Office of General Counsel of the U.S. Department of Energy, located at 1000 Independence Ave, SW, Washington, DC, 20585. Mr. Meier and Ms. Medlyn wish to represent the Federal Executive Agencies (the FEA) *pro hac vice* in the above-referenced matter.

2. Mr. Meier is not admitted to practice in Missouri but is a member in good standing of the District of Columbia Bar and the Maryland State Bar. Mr. Meier has never been subject to disciplinary proceedings of any kind.

3. Ms. Medlyn is not admitted to practice in Missouri but is a member in good standing of the South Carolina State Bar. Ms. Medlyn has never been subject to disciplinary proceedings of any kind.

4. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 6.01(m), a fee of \$820 has been paid to the Clerk of the Missouri Supreme Court, and the certificate attached hereto was issued on May 20, 2024 by the Clerk of the Supreme Court.

5. Mr. Meier and Ms. Medlyn are associated in this matter with James T. Van Biber, III. Mr. Van Biber is employed as Regional Counsel, Heartland Region, General Services Administration, 2300 Main Street, Suite 4NW419, Kansas City, MO 64108. Mr. Van Biber is a member in good standing of the Missouri Bar (Missouri Bar No. 48018) and is qualified to practice before this Commission pursuant to 20 CSR 4240-2.040(3)(A). Mr. Meier and Ms. Medlyn respectfully designate Mr. Van Biber as associate counsel. He has entered his appearance on behalf of the Federal Executive Agencies in this proceeding by his inclusion in the Motion for Leave to File Late Application to Intervene and Application to Intervene of the FEA.

6. If this application to appear and participate *pro hac vice* is granted, Mr. Meier and Ms. Medlyn agree to abide by the Rules of the Commission, including all disciplinary rules, and notify the Commission immediately of any matter affecting their standing at the bar of any court.
