On April 13, 2017, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed its 2016 Renewable Energy Standard Compliance Report and 2017 Compliance Plan, as required by Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-20.100(8). Renew Missouri Advocates applied to intervene on April 18.

This is not a contested case, and any interested person or entity may file comments regarding Ameren Missouri's report or plan without the necessity of applying to be a party to this proceeding. However, under the Commission's confidential information rule, 4 CSR 240-2.135, confidential information may only be disclosed to a party. Therefore, Renew Missouri must be made a party if it is to see the confidential portions of Ameren Missouri's report and plan.

The Commission finds that allowing Renew Missouri to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(3), the Commission will grant Renew Missouri's application to intervene.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Application to Intervene of Renew Missouri Advocates is granted.
