On February 16, 2024,¹ the Commission issued its *Order Setting Procedural Schedule*. Among the deadlines established by the procedural schedule were those for direct testimony, rebuttal testimony, and surrebuttal testimony on May 10, May 31, and June 18, respectively.

On May 9, Missouri Coalition for Fair Competition and Corey Malone filed direct testimony. On May 23, the Commission issued a notice of deficiency as to the format of the direct testimony. As a result, Complainants re-filed direct testimony on May 30, the deadline to correct the deficiency set by the Commission.

On May 30, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed a *Motion to Amend Procedural Schedule and Motion for Expedited Treatment* (Motion) requesting to amend the procedural schedule so that Ameren Missouri can adequately respond to the re-filed direct testimony of May 30, proposing revised dates of June 5 and June 18 for
