**NOTICE OF EX PARTE COMMUNICATION**

Issue Date: May 31, 2024

On May 23, 2024,<sup>1</sup> the Commission issued its *Order Setting a Deadline for Exhibits, Objections, and Directing the Filing of Post-Hearing Briefs* in which the parties were ordered to file all exhibits by May 24. Over one hundred exhibits were received in various emails. On May 30, the presiding judge sent an email to all parties describing then still inaccessible exhibits for the ease of the parties in accessing those exhibits.

The same day, Complainant Aquilla Canada replied to the presiding judge’s email, referencing substantive issues in the case and inadmissible evidence.

Pursuant to Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-4.020(3), the parties are given notice of the ex parte communication, a copy of which is attached to this notice. As the evidentiary period closed on May 24, any exhibits or evidence filed after that date will not be considered.
