The Chapter 22 IRP rules (20 CSR 4240-22) outline the requirements for performing IRPs:

20 CSR 4240-22.010(1):The commission's policy goal in promulgating this chapter is to set minimum standards to govern the scope and objectives of the resource planning process that is required of electric utilities subject to its jurisdiction in order to ensure that the public interest is adequately served. Compliance with these rules shall not be construed to result in commission approval of the utility's resource plans, resource acquisition strategies, or investment decisions.

As noted in the excerpt above, these rules do not result in the approval of specific resource plans, resource acquisition strategies, or investment decisions because those approvals occur through other cases, but they do govern the requirements of the resource planning *process*.

To my knowledge, Evergy West has never been found by the Commission not to be in compliance with the requirements of the State of Missouri related to integrated resource planning. The various requirements may be found in Chapter 22 rules, Missouri statutes, and orders of the Commission which are available at the PSC Data Center or on line at the PSC website.
