ORDER ADOPTING FILING DEADLINE FOR A STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT

MCImetro Access Transmission Services, LLC (MCImetro) filed an application on June 22, 1998, for a certificate of service authority to provide basic local, local exchange and interexchange telecommunications services in the State of Missouri.

Southwestern Bell Telephone Company was granted intervention on August 5, and the parties were directed to file either a proposed procedural schedule or a date for the filing of a Stipulation and Agreement no later than September 3.

MCImetro filed a Procedural Schedule on September 3, stating that the parties were in agreement that a Stipulation and Agreement could be filed by October 5. MCImetro asked the Commission to approve the proposed deadline for filing of a Stipulation and Agreement.

The Commission has considered MCImetro's motion and will adopt the proposed filing deadline. The parties shall file a Stipulation and Agreement no later than October 5 or, if no agreement can be reached, a proposed procedural schedule with dates for the filing of testimony.



IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the parties shall file a Stipulation and Agreement or, if no agreement can be reached, a proposed procedural schedule no later than October 5, 1998.
 - 2. That this order shall become effective on September 9, 1998.


