KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (GMO) filed its 2016 Renewable Energy Standard Compliance Report and Request for Waiver on April 13, 2017, and filed a correction to that report on May 8. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-20.100(8) requires Staff to file a report about the compliance plan, and offers other interested persons or entities an opportunity to file comments. Staff filed its report on May 30.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-20.100(8)(F) allows the Commission to direct GMO to provide additional information or to address any concerns or deficiencies identified by Staff or any other commenter. Before deciding whether any additional information is required or whether any concerns or deficiencies need to be addressed, the Commission will establish a time for the filing of responses to Staff's report.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any person or entity wishing to respond to Staff's Report on KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company's 2016 Renewable Energy Standard Compliance Report and Request for Waiver shall do so no later than June 15, 2017.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
