Dear Judge Dippell,

On behalf of Missouri-American Water Company (“MAWC” or “Company”), I am providing herewith to the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) for filing certain tariff sheets in electronic form consisting of revised water and sewer tariff sheets. The proposed tariff sheets are listed on Appendix A, bear a date of issue of July 1, 2024, and an effective date of July 31, 2024.

The purpose of this filing is to implement a general rate increase for water and sewer service provided by MAWC. The revised rates are designed to produce \$166.6 million in additional annual water and sewer revenues (excluding gross receipts and sales taxes) or a 34.4% increase over revenues authorized in MAWC’s last general rate case (WR-2022-0303) and subsequent WSIRA cases (WO-2023-0427 and WO-2024-0195).

The water rates have been designed to implement the Company’s proposal to move to consolidated tariff pricing. Provided herewith as Appendix B is a description of the impact MAWC’s proposal would have on residential customers in each district utilizing 3,000, 5,000, and, 7,000 gallons monthly usage levels.

Revenue Stabilization Mechanism (RSM)

AVAILABILITY – All residential (“domestic”), commercial, other public authority and sale for resale metered water customers.

SECTION A - DEFINITIONS

Actual Revenue (AR) shall mean the actual dollar amount of revenues billed to customers for the identified Service Classifications, excluding revenues arising from adjustments under this tariff and any other tariff, which were billed for the applicable Fiscal Year, excluding revenues from acquisitions approved by the Commission that have not yet been approved in a general rate case and any revenues collected under Rate I (Sheet RT 10) or Rate W (Sheets RT 11.1 and RT 11.2).

Actual Production Costs (APC) shall mean the actual dollar amount of power, chemicals, purchased water and waste disposal incurred by the Company in the Fiscal Year, excluding production costs from acquisitions approved by the Commission that have not yet been approved in a general rate case.

Effective Period shall mean the period for which the adjustments in Section B are to be billed to customers, and shall be the nine-month period April through December after the Filing Month.

Effective Period Usage (G) shall mean the number of 100 gallon units delivered to customers by the Company, including the number of 100 gallon units for the applicable Effective Period.

Filing Month shall mean the month in which an adjustment is determined by the Company and submitted to the Commission, on or before January 31.

Fiscal Year shall mean the Fiscal Year of the Company that ended as of the most recent December 31.

Interest (i) shall mean the Company short-term interest borrowing rate.

Previous Amortization Period shall mean the nine-month reconciliation amortization period that ended as of the most recent Fiscal Year.

Rate Case Revenue (RCR) shall mean the dollar amount of revenues reflected in the revenue requirements approved by the Commission for the applicable Service Classifications in the Company’s most recent general rate case. In a month or year in which new rates come into effect, the RCR shall be prorated based upon the number of days in the month or year under the old rates and the number of days in the month or year under the new rates.

Rate Case Production Costs (RPC) shall mean the dollar amount of power, chemicals, purchased water and waste disposal expenses reflected in revenue requirements approved by the Commission in the Company’s most recent general rate case. In a month or year in which new rates come into effect, the RPC shall be prorated based upon the number of days in the month or year under the old rates and the number of days in the month or year under the new rates.

Upcoming Amortization Period shall mean the nine-month reconciliation amortization period commencing on April 1 following the Fiscal Year.

SECTION B – DETERMINATION OF ADJUSTMENT

SECTION C – REPORTS AND RECONCILIATIONS

The Company shall file with the Commission on or before January 30 of each year, the RSM calculation and support for any annual adjustments to be effective under this tariff. The Commission Staff will have 60 days to review. The reconciliation amount will be surcharged from April 1 through December 31 of each calendar year. Any credit will be issued as soon as administratively possible.

Rule 9 – Bills for Water Service

- A. The charges for water service shall be at the rates specified in the applicable Rate Schedules. The point of sale shall be at the meter installation for all metered service or at the tap for all unmetered services. Service charges for activation or discontinuance of service are set forth in the applicable Schedule of Service Charges. +
- B. A Customer who has made application for water service to a premises shall be held liable for all charges for water furnished to such premises until the Customer’s requested date of termination.
- C. Bills for water service will be distributed on a monthly or quarterly basis. The due date on the bill shall be twenty-one (21) days after the “date of rendition” of the bill to the Customer. The Customer’s bill will be due and payable by this due date. The date printed on the bill shall be no less than twenty-one (21) days after the date of the postmark or the electronic transmission of the bill. Any accounts remaining unpaid after the due date shall be considered delinquent and the Company may take such action as specified in its filed rules and regulations. *
- D. A separate Customer account shall be created, with separate billings rendered for each meter installation, and the use of water by the same Customer in the same or different premises or localities will not be combined unless an agreement exists between the Customer and the Company for combining multiple meter readings into one bill.
- E. Each Customer is responsible for furnishing the Company with the correct bill mailing address. Failure to receive bills will not be considered an excuse for non-payment nor reason to permit an extension of the date when the account would be considered delinquent.
- F. Bills and notices relating to the Company or its business will be mailed or delivered to the service address entered in the Customer’s application or transmitted via the Internet or electronic mail for customers enrolled in paperless billing unless the Company is notified by the Customer of a change of address or an alternate mailing address. * *
- G. Payments shall be made at authorized locations as designated by the Company.
- H. The Company shall have the right to read meters and render bills either monthly, quarterly, semi- annually or annually and such bills shall be due and payable on the due date indicated on the bill.
- I. Water bills are rendered for the entire premises as served through a single metering point, whether served by a single meter, a compound meter, or a series of meters set on a service line, and will not be subdivided by the Company.
- J. The Company may render a bill based on estimated usage if:
 - 1. Extreme weather conditions, emergencies, labor agreements, or work stoppages prevent actual meter readings; or

- 2. The Company is unable to obtain access to the Customer’s premises for the purposes of reading the meter, or in situations where conditions make or the Customer makes reading the meter unnecessarily difficult.
- K. When the Company renders an estimated bill, it shall clearly and conspicuously note on the bill that it is based on estimated usage.
- L. The Company will not be bound by bills rendered under mistake of fact as to the quantity of service rendered, or as a result of clerical error.
- M. When bills are rendered for a period of less than a complete billing period due to the connection or termination of service, the billing shall be for the proportionate part of the billing period. Where water usage is the basis for the charge, it will be at the appropriate rate for water usage unless other charges apply based on local tariffs.
- N. Where a meter fails to register, or if the Company is unable to obtain a meter reading due to reasons outlined in Rule 9J. above, the Customer’s bill for water usage shall be estimated by using the actual usage during the same billing period, at the same premises, in the most recent year. If no actual usage is found for the comparison period of the prior year, the Company will base its estimate on actual usage found during the prior billing period. If no actual usage is found for the prior billing period, the Company will base its estimate upon average annual usage of customers in the same customer class within the same meter reading route and under the same tariff schedule.
- O. Paperless Billing. The Company will deliver to active participants in the Company’s electronic platform, currently called My Water, an electronic image of their bills through the use of the Internet. Customers actively using the platform have the opportunity to convert their account to receive their bills exclusively through this platform, instead of mailing or hand delivery of a bill. In addition, all new customers who sign up for the platform will be notified at the time of enrollment that they will receive paperless bills unless they opt out when setting up their account on the platform. Customers on paperless billing receive notices through electronic mail when their bills are available, approaching due dates, or past due. Customers may pay the bill using any payment option available. Customers may terminate paperless billing at any time.

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
