Dear Judge Dippell,

On behalf of Missouri-American Water Company ("MAWC" or "Company"), I am providing herewith to the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") for filing certain tariff sheets in electronic form consisting of revised water and sewer tariff sheets. The proposed tariff sheets are listed on Appendix A, bear a date of issue of July 1, 2024, and an effective date of July 31, 2024.

The purpose of this filing is to implement a general rate increase for water and sewer service provided by MAWC. The revised rates are designed to produce \$166.6 million in additional annual water and sewer revenues (excluding gross receipts and sales taxes) or a 34.4% increase over revenues authorized in MAWC's last general rate case (WR-2022-0303) and subsequent WSIRA cases (WO-2023-0427 and WO-2024-0195).

The water rates have been designed to implement the Company's proposal to move to consolidated tariff pricing. Provided herewith as Appendix B is a description of the impact MAWC's proposal would have on residential customers in each district utilizing 3,000, 5,000, and, 7,000 gallons monthly usage levels.

PRO-RATA ADJUSTMENT OF MONTHLY MINIMUM CHARGE – If the customer is forced to close operations of its

works for a period of 10 days or more on account of accidents, fires, damage to works, strikes of its own employees, act of God, governmental regulations or other physical cause not reasonably within its control, and customer gives water company written notice not later than forty days after such occurrence, the customer will be entitled to pro rata reduction in the monthly minimum charge which is based on 60% of the maximum usage during the previous months of June, July, August, or September for the period during which the customer is unable to use full water service for such cause.

DURATION OF CLASSIFICATION – Customers electing Tariff Rate J are required to remain in this classification for a period of at least twelve (12) months.

A Rate J customer whose usage is less than 450,000 gallons per month more than two times during a twelve (12) month period will no longer meet the eligibility requirements of this classification.

Customers who no longer meet the eligibility requirements of this classification, or elect to leave this classification, will be reclassified to Tariff Rate A, and must remain in the Rate A classification for a minimum of twelve (12) months and meet the monthly minimum usage requirements again before being reclassified under the Tariff Rate J.

PAYMENT TERMS - All bills for service under this schedule will be rendered in arrears on a monthly basis. The due date on the tariff shall be ten (10) days after the "date of rendition" of the bill to the customer. The customer's bill will be due and payable after this due date. The delinquent date printed on the bill will not be less than twenty-one (21) days after it is mailed, sent electronically, or hand delivered. Any accounts remaining unpaid at the expiration of twenty-one (21) days shall be considered delinquent and the Company may take such action as specified in its filed rules and regulations.

PRO-RATA ADJUSTMENT OF MONTHLY MINIMUM CHARGE – If the customer is forced to close operations of its works for a period of 10 days or more on account of accidents, fires, damage to works, strikes of its own employees, act of God, governmental regulations or other physical cause not reasonably within its control, and customer gives water company written notice not later than forty days after such occurrence, the customer will be entitled to pro rata reduction in the monthly minimum charge which is based on 60% of the maximum usage during the previous months of June, July, August, or September for the period during which the customer is unable to use full water service for such cause.

DURATION OF CLASSIFICATION – Customers electing Tariff Rate J are required to remain in this classification for a period of at least twelve (12) months.

A Rate J customer whose usage is less than 450,000 gallons per month more than two times during a twelve (12) month period will no longer meet the eligibility requirements of this classification.

Customers who no longer meet the eligibility requirements of this classification, or elect to leave this classification, will be reclassified to Tariff Rate A, and must remain in the Rate A classification for a minimum of twelve (12) months and meet the monthly minimum usage requirements again before being reclassified under the Tariff Rate J.

PAYMENT TERMS - All bills for service under this schedule will be rendered in arrears on a monthly basis. The due date on the tariff shall be ten (10) days after the "date of rendition" of the bill to the customer. The customer's bill will be due and payable after this due date. The delinquent date printed on the bill will not be less than twenty-one (21) days after it is mailed, sent electronically, or hand delivered. Any accounts remaining unpaid at the expiration of twenty-one (21) days shall be considered delinquent and the Company may take such action as specified in its filed rules and regulations.

TAXES - These rates do not include any municipal, state or federal taxes computed on either billing or consumption basis. Any such taxes applicable shall be added as separate items in rendering each bill.
