ORDER GRANTING APPLICATIONS TO INTERVENE

On June 7, 2024, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed an application requesting that the Commission grant them a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to construct, install, own, operate, maintain and otherwise control and manage the Castle Bluff Project in St. Louis, Missouri. On June 18, 2024, Renew Missouri Advocates d/b/a Renew Missouri filed an application to intervene. On June 25 and June 27, 2024, Midwest Energy Consumers Group (MECG) and Grain Belt Express, LLC (Grain Belt Express), respectively, filed applications to intervene. A prehearing conference was held on July 1, 2024 and no parties objected to the interventions. The applications satisfy the requirements of Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.075, and intervention will be granted.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Renew Missouri, MECG and Grain Belt Express's applications to intervene are granted.
2. This order is effective when issued.
