NOTICE OF DISMISSAL

COMES NOW Aaron Fallon (Complainant”) and states the following to the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) as his *Notice of Dismissal*:

1. After discussions between Complainant and Missouri-American Water Company (“MAWC”), Complainant and MAWC have reached an agreement that resolves this Complaint.
2.
