JOINT MOTION FOR EXTENSION

COMES NOW the Staff ("Staff") of the Missouri Public Service Commission, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren Missouri"), the Office of Public Counsel ("OPC"), Renew Missouri Advocates d/b/a Renew Missouri ("Renew Missouri"), Natural Resources Defense Council ("NRDC"), Midwest Energy Consumers Group ("MECG"), and Consumers Council of Missouri ("Consumers Council") (collectively, the "Parties"), and for their *Joint Motion for Extension* respectfully state:

- 1. On June 14, 2024, the Parties filed with the Commission a *Joint Motion to Amend Procedural Schedule*.¹ The Parties agreed to amend the schedule by extending discovery and the filing of the *List of Issues, List of Witnesses, and Order of Cross-Examination* to June 30, 2024. The Parties also agreed to extend the evidentiary hearing dates from July 24-26, 2024 to July 22-26, 2024.
- 2. The Commission issued its *Order Directing Filing* on June 17, 2024, extending the deadlines for discovery and the filing of the *List of Issues, List of Witnesses, and Order of Cross-Examination* to July 1, 2024. The Commission did not rule on the request to extend the evidentiary hearing dates.

¹ At the time of the filing, Renew Missouri had not yet responded whether it was in agreement or opposed to the Parties' request.

- 3. The OPC filed a *Motion to Schedule Procedural Conference* on June 21, 2024, asking that the Commission schedule a procedural conference as soon as possible to discuss the extension. After the Parties made a joint filing on June 26, 2024 with available dates for a discovery conference, the Commission issued an order on June 28, 2024 setting a procedural conference for July 2, 2024 at 9:00 A.M.
- 4. Although a procedural conference was held on July 2, 2024, the Parties were not able complete the discussion regarding the List of Issues. So that the Parties may continue to discuss the *List of Issues, List of Witnesses, and Order of Cross-Examination*, the Parties respectfully request the Commission extend the filing date from July 3, 2024 to July 10, 2024.
- 5. Position statements are not scheduled to be filed until July 17, 2024, and the evidentiary hearing is still several weeks away. No party will be prejudiced by extending the deadline to file *the List of Issues, List of Witnesses, and Order of Cross-Examination* from July 3, 2024 to July 10, 2024.

WHEREFORE, the Parties respectfully request that the Commission extend the filing date for the *List of Issues, List of Witnesses, and Order of Cross-Examination* from July 3, 2024, to July 10, 2024.
