**MOTION TO CONSOLIDATE**

**COMES NOW** Confluence Rivers Utility Operating Company, Inc. (“Confluence Rivers”), by and through the undersigned counsel, and for its *Motion to Consolidate* states as follows to the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”):

1. On July 5, 2024, Confluence Rivers filed an *Application and Motion for Waiver*, requesting certificates of convenience and necessity to provide water and sewer service as an Expansion of its Existing Service Area (Creekside Development). The cases were assigned File Nos. WA-2025-0012 and SA-2025-0013.

2. The applicant in both cases is Confluence Rivers and the entity from whom Confluence Rivers proposes to buy the assets, Lincoln County Water and Sewer, LLC, operates the water and sewer systems in question in both cases. The above-captioned cases will thus reference identical parties, contain common questions of law and fact, and will contain primarily the same filings. Previous cases of this nature have been consolidated for the ease of filings and discovery.

3. The Commission has stated, “Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.110(3) allows for the consolidation of cases with related questions of law or fact.”<sup>1</sup> Therefore, Confluence Rivers




