15 All right. Hearing none, we will proceed
16 to taking comments on the proposed rulemaking. As a
17 reminder because this is a rulemaking proceeding, this
18 is a non-contested case and counsel is not needed for
19 those who would otherwise need counsel. No cross
20 examination will be allowed, and comments do not have
21 to be made under oath.

22 So let me open the hearing up for comments.
23 Is there anyone who would like to make any comments in
24 favor of the proposed amendment?

25 MS. KERR: Yes. Staff filed comments on

1 July -- I believe it was July 3rd, staff filed
2 comments on the proposed amendment. They are in the
3 record. I don't know. Do we need to actually do
4 anything on the record, just note that it was filed on
5 July 3rd?

6 LAW JUDGE PRIDGIN: That's perfectly fine.
7 Thank you.

8 MS. KERR: It was in support of the -- of
9 the rule.

10 LAW JUDGE PRIDGIN: All right. And
11 Ms. Kerr, thank you. Any -- any other comments in
12 favor of the proposed amendment? Any comments against
13 the proposed amendment?

14 All right. Anything further either from
15 counsel or from the bench before we adjourn this
16 hearing?

17 All right. Hearing nothing, that will
18 conclude the rulemaking hearing in file number
19 MX-2024-0310. Thank you very much. We are off the
20 record.

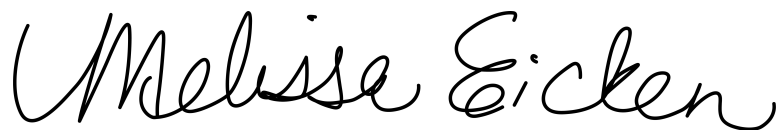
