On May 24, 2024, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed an application requesting a certificate of convenience and necessity.

The Commission directed notice and set a deadline of June 13, 2024, for applications to intervene. On May 29, 2024, Renew Missouri Associates d/b/a Renew Missouri filed an application to intervene. Ten days have passed and no parties have filed an objection to Renew Missouri's application to intervene.¹

After considering the unopposed application to intervene, the Commission finds that Renew Missouri has interests which are different from that of the general public and allowing Renew Missouri to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.075(3), the Commission will grant the application to intervene.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The application to intervene of Renew Missouri is granted.
- 2. This order shall be effective when issued.
