ORDER ESTABLISHING PROTECTIVE ORDER

On May 24, 2024, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed an application requesting a certificate of convenience and necessity. On the same date, Ameren Missouri filed a *Motion for Protective Order*, requesting that the Commission issue an order safeguarding highly confidential information among the parties.

The motion seeks protection for (1) the negotiated terms and conditions of the Engineering, Procurement and Construction (EPC) Agreement, attached as Schedule SDW-2 to Ameren Missouri witness Scott Wibbenmeyer's direct testimony, and the scope of work under the EPC, attached to the application as Schedule D; (2) cost and pricing information reflected in Mr. Wibbenmeyer's direct testimony; (3) the Procurement Plan in Schedule D; (4) the terms and conditions of agreements (and documents reflecting such terms and conditions) with entities who will construct the solar and transmission-related assets covered by the EPC Agreement in Schedule F; and (5) responses (and documents reflecting responses) to Ameren Missouri's solar generation Request for Proposal (RFP). Ameren Missouri also seeks protection for any additional information falling within these categories to be produced in discovery or in later-filed testimony, or other evidence presented in this case, and designated as highly confidential.

Ten days have passed and no parties have filed an objection to Ameren Missouri's

motion.¹ The Commission will grant the motion for protective order.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Ameren Missouri's *Motion for Protective Order* is granted as to the following

information designated by Ameren Missouri as "highly confidential":

- a. the negotiated terms and conditions of the Engineering, Procurement and Construction (EPC) Agreement, attached as Schedule SDW-2 to Ameren Missouri witness Scott Wibbenmeyer's direct testimony, and the scope of work under the EPC, attached to the application as Schedule D;
- b. cost and pricing information reflected in Mr. Wibbenmeyer's direct testimony;
- c. the Procurement Plan in Schedule D;
- d. the terms and conditions of agreements (and documents reflecting such terms and conditions) with entities who will construct the solar and transmission-related assets covered by the EPC Agreement in Schedule F;
- d. responses (and documents reflecting responses) to Ameren Missouri's solar generation Request for Proposal (RFP); and
- e. any additional information falling within these categories to be produced in discovery or in later-filed testimony, or other evidence presented in this case, and designated as highly confidential.
- 2. Information designated by Ameren Missouri as "highly confidential" shall be

disclosed only to attorneys of record for all parties, to state agency parties and their employees covered by statutory confidentiality requirements, and to designated outside experts of any non-state agency party. Such information shall not be shared with any employees of a non-state agency party, but, if shared, shall be promptly returned to the party's attorney of record.

¹ Per Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.080(13), parties are allowed ten days from the date of filing in which to respond to any pleading, unless otherwise ordered by the Commission.

3. Except for attorneys of record for all parties, and employees of state agency employees covered by statutory confidentiality requirements, all persons authorized to access "confidential" information in this case shall complete the nondisclosure agreement attached to this order as Exhibit A.

4. Except for attorneys of record for all parties, and employees of state agency employees covered by statutory confidentiality requirements, all persons authorized to access "highly confidential" information in this case shall complete the nondisclosure agreement attached to this order as Exhibit B.

5. This order shall be effective when issued.
