On January 14, 2014¹, the Commission received the above-referenced application. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-32.200(4) requires the Commission to issue notice to several different entities. The Commission ordered its Staff to file a list of entities that it believes the Commission should notify to satisfy that rule. Staff did so on January 24.

The Commission will issue notice as recommended by Staff.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Data Center of the Commission shall provide notice to the entities listed in Attachment A of Staff's January 24, 2014 pleading. This notice shall bear the date that it is sent by the Data Center, and allow 20 days for intervention.
2. The Public Information Office of the Commission shall provide notice of the application to the members of the General Assembly representing residents of the counties and to news media serving residents of the counties listed in paragraph 30 of the Reapplication for 211 Authority.

3. The United Way of Great St. Louis, Inc., shall notify all the agencies it funds.
4. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
