- A. EMW's Non-Standard Metering Service tariff allows customers to opt-out of using an automated meter reading device. These customers pay an initial one-time meter setup fee of \$150 and a \$45 monthly non-standard meter read charge.
 - Q. Is the initial one-time set meter setup fee of \$150 charge reasonable?
- A. No. Based on the information that the company has provided, the cost of a non-standard meter is \$99.28 and the cost of installation is \$41.20. The charge should be lowered to \$141 to better reflect actual costs.
 - Q. Is the \$45 monthly non-standard meter read charge reasonable?
 - A. The monthly charge of \$45 is reasonable.
 - Q. Do other utilities allow customers to opt-out of advanced meters?
- A. Yes. Several electric and water utilities regulated by this Commission allow customers to opt-out of advanced meters. The table below is a non-exhaustive summary of other advanced meter opt-out rates:
