**ORDER GRANTING MOTIONS TO APPEAR REMOTELY AND
ORDER GRANTING REQUEST TO BE EXCUSED FROM HEARING**

On July 10, 2024, Ameren Missouri filed a Motion to Appear Remotely. Ameren Missouri explains that one of its witnesses, Jeffrey Huber, has filed testimony to which no one has responded. In an effort to save time and expense, Ameren Missouri has asked the Commission to allow Mr. Huber to appear for this hearing remotely.

Similarly, on July 16, Renew Missouri filed a Motion to Appear Remotely. Renew Missouri explains that to avoid scheduling difficulties and time and expense, it would like to appear remotely for the hearing.

Finally, Midwest Energy Consumers Group (MECG) asks to be excused from this hearing. MECG states that it has not filed testimony, and it does not plan to cross-examine witnesses or to make an opening statement.

The Commission finds the motions reasonable, and will grant them.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Motions to Appear Remotely filed by Ameren Missouri and Renew Missouri are granted.
2. The Request to Be Excused from Hearing filed by MECG is granted.
3. This order shall be effective when issued.
