## ORDER ACKNOWLEDGING VOLUNTARY DISMISSAL AND CLOSING FILE

The Missouri Public Service Commission is acknowledging the voluntary dismissal of this action and closing the file.

The Commission's regulations provide:

An applicant . . . may voluntarily dismiss an application . . . without an order of the commission at any time before prepared testimony has been filed or oral evidence has been offered, by filing a notice of dismissal with the commission and serving a copy on all parties.<sup>1</sup>

On March 30, 2010, applicants filed a *Response of Kansas City Power & Light Company and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company* ("response"). The response, noting alternative routes to the relief sought in the application, withdraws the application and so constitutes a notice of dismissal.

Because no party has filed prepared testimony or offered oral evidence, the response dismisses the case as a matter of right upon filing and service. The response includes a certificate of service to all parties through counsel of record. Therefore, the Commission will acknowledge the voluntary dismissal of this action and close this file.
