On December 30, 2011, Kansas City Power & Light Company and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company ("Companies") filed an application for an Accounting Authority Order that would allow the Companies to undertake certain accounting procedures in connection with their electrical operations in relation to the costs of compliance with Missouri's Renewable Energy Standard Law.
