ORDER GRANTING LEAVE TO APPEAR PRO HAC VICE

On July 23, 2024, Lindsay W. Ingram III, Monica H. Braun, W. Duncan Crosby III, and Matthew R. Parson (Movants) jointly filed a motion for leave to appear *pro hac vice* as attorneys for The Empire District Electric Company d/b/a Liberty.

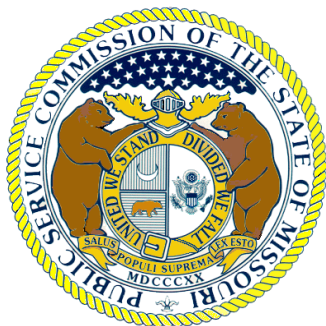
