**STAFF’S STATUS REPORT**

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Staff”) and for its Staff Report states:

On July 5, 2024, Confluence Rivers Utility Operating Company, Inc. (Confluence Rivers) filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission requesting that the Commission grant it a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) to construct, install, own, operate, maintain and otherwise control and manage a water system and a sewer system for the public in an area of Lincoln County, Missouri. Confluence Rivers requested consolidation of files WA-2025-0012 and SA-2025-0013) and a waiver of the Rule 20 CSR 4240-4.017(1)(D)60-day notice requirement. On July 9, 2024, the Commission ordered Staff to file a pleading no later than July 30, 2024, indicating when it could provide the Commission with a recommendation regarding Confluence Rivers’ application. Staff advises he Commission that, taking into consideration the pending rate cases and press of other business, it will need another sixty (60) days to prepare and file a recommendation.

**WHEREFORE**, Staff prays that the Commission will accept this pleading as compliant with the Commissions orders.
