DIRECTORY SERVICES

6.1 GENERAL

- 6.1.1 Telephone Directory Distribution - The Telephone Company distributes to its customers without charge a directory of customer listings which are generally necessary for the efficient use of the service. Any additional directories or information requested by a customer will be furnished where, in the opinion of the Company, such provisions will lend to a more efficient use of the service by that particular customer. Other directories will be furnished at the discretion of the Company at a reasonable rate.
- 6.1.2 Telephone Directory Ownership - Directories regularly furnished to customers are the property of the Telephone Company, are loaned to customers only as an aid to the use of the telephone service and are to be returned to the Telephone Company upon request. The Telephone Company shall have the right to make a charge for directories issued in replacement of directories destroyed, defaced or mutilated while in possession of customers.

6.2 DIRECTORY LISTINGS

- 6.2.1 The rates and regulations for directory listings in this section apply only to the alphabetical directory containing the regular alphabetical list of names of customers.
- 6.2.2 The alphabetical list of names of customers is for the purpose of informing calling parties of the telephone numbers of customers and those entitled to use customers' service, and special position or arrangement of names is not contemplated.
- 6.2.3 The Telephone Company limits the length of any listing in the directory by the use of abbreviations when, in the opinion of the Telephone Company, the clearness of the listing or the identification of the customer is not impaired thereby.
- 6.2.4 Listings must conform to the Telephone Company's practices with respect to its directories.

6.3.6 When the Telephone Company publishes an alphabetical directory of subscriber listings in two sections, one section containing a list of individual names and the other section consisting of a list of business names, primary and regular extra listings of business service subscribers consisting of the names of individuals will be published in both alphabetical sections without additional charge. Primary and regular extra listings of residential service subscribers will be published in both alphabetical sections without additional charge if the listings are indented under business listings consisting of the name of an individual. Primary and regular extra listings of residence service subscribers whose listings contain a healing profession designation will also be included in both alphabetical sections without additional charge.(1)

6.3.7 When the Telephone Company publishes a separate section in its directories of telephone numbers for government offices, the primary listing of the government office will be placed in this section. Regular extra listings may be purchased by the government office in the alphabetical section in which business listings regularly appear.
