I appreciate the prehearing conference being setup. At that time we will address our concerns.

There are three main concerns.

- 1) Ameren Missouri failed to include 3 additional pages of that letter.
- 2) Ameren Missouri has in fact a copy of the bank statement. In addition their Regulatory Liason and co-counsel were even giving a digital copy which will be addressed at the pre-hearing.
- 3) The energy assessment that Ameren Missouri gave staff of the Commission doesn't address the kilowatt usage breakdown or does it give a breakdown of data specifically from December 2023 through July of 2024. Ameren Missouri only sent up to 5/15/2023.

Ameren Missouri didn't answer the correct data information in the complaint. They didn't provide the Commission data from May and June of 2024, like I specified in my Complaint. In fact, Ameren avoided it.

Please keep in mind that I had service only until May 18, 2023 and not until December again.

As usual, Ameren Missouri will intentionally leave out crucial data.

In addition I have to inform parties that we did explore our rights and have amended a lawsuit that we currently have against Ameren Missouri on other matters . While it was opened two years ago, we left the option open without service.

We amended the filing today and included newly discovered information that should be presented in court. That matter is 2022-SC-00247. In fact in our new amended filing to the courts, all the information requested will be attached to that as exhibits to prove our claim.

However, at the prehearing conference I would like to have a slideshow presentation to show the actual meter data from December 2023 through July of 2024, in which Ameren Missouri intentionally ignored the complaint 100% and daily usage kilowatt hours.
