## ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE, SETTING INTERVENTION DEADLINE, AND ADDING A PARTY

Issue Date: August 7, 2024 Effective Date: August 7, 2024

This order provides notice of this application to interested parties, establishes a deadline for intervention and for requesting a hearing, and joins the other party to the Interconnection Agreement, DISH Wireless L.L.C., as a party to this proceeding.

On July 24, 2024, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company d/b/a AT&T Missouri filed an application with the Commission for approval of an Amendment (Amendment) to a negotiated Interconnection Agreement (Agreement) with DISH Wireless L.L.C. under the provisions of the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act). AT&T Missouri stated that there are no unresolved issues and that the Amendment complies with Section 252(e) of the Act in that it is consistent with the public interest, convenient and necessary, and is not discriminatory to nonparty carriers.

AT&T Missouri has also requested a waiver of the 60-day notice requirement for good cause shown,<sup>1</sup> having had no communication with the Commission within the prior 150 days regarding substantive issues likely to be in this case, other than those pleadings filed of record.

Although DISH Wireless L.L.C. is a party to the Amendment, it did not join in the application. Because DISH Wireless L.L.C. is a necessary party to a full and fair adjudication of this matter, the Commission will add DISH Wireless L.L.C. as a party to this case.

The Act provides that the Agreement must be approved unless the state commission finds that the Agreement discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the Agreement, or that implementation of the Agreement is not consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity.<sup>2</sup> Section 252(e)(4) of the Act provides that if the Commission has not acted to approve or reject an Agreement within 90 days after submission, the Agreement shall be deemed approved. That date is October 22, 2024.

The Commission finds that proper persons shall be allowed 15 days from the issuance of this order to file a motion for hearing. The Commission also finds that notice of this application shall be sent to all interexchange and local exchange telecommunications companies. The Staff of the Commission (Staff) will be directed to provide recommendation.

#### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Commission's Data Center shall send a copy of this order to all interexchange and local exchange telecommunications companies.
  - 2. DISH Wireless L.L.C. is made a party to this case.
- 3. Any party wishing to intervene or request a hearing shall do so by filing a pleading no later than August 22, 2024.

- 4. Staff shall file a recommendation advising either approval or rejection of this Amendment and giving the reasons therefor, or a status report regarding when Staff anticipates filing its recommendation, no later than September 6, 2024.
  - 5. This order shall be effective when issued.
