ORDER ESTABLISHING A PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On December 1, 2010, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, filed an application to implement the true-up of the first Recovery Period under its fuel adjustment clause. Staff filed a recommendation regarding that application on December 30, in which it advises the Commission to reject the true-up adjustment proposed by Ameren Missouri and to impose an adjustment calculated by Staff. On January 24, 2011, the Commission suspended the decision-making timeline established by Commission rule and directed the parties to submit a proposed procedural schedule.

Staff and Ameren Missouri submitted a proposed procedural schedule on February 4. The parties indicate that the relevant facts are undisputed and that their dispute can be resolved on the law. They propose to file a joint stipulation of facts, followed by legal briefs. They do not propose to schedule an evidentiary hearing.

The Commission will accept the recommendation of the parties and will establish the procedural schedule they have proposed.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:
