## ORDER EXTENDING BRIEFING SCHEDULE AND FURTHER SUSPENDING TRUE-UP TIMELINE

The procedural schedule for this case requires Ameren Missouri to file its reply brief by May 20, 2011. On May 18, Ameren Missouri filed a motion asking for a two-week extension to file its brief. Ameren Missouri's motion also suggests that the true-up timeline be extended by two weeks from June 30 to reflect the additional time allowed for Ameren Missouri to file its reply brief. The motion represents that the other parties to this case, Staff and Public Counsel, do not object to the requested extensions.

Ameren Missouri's motion is reasonable and is not opposed by any party. The Commission will grant the motion.

- 2. The briefing schedule is modified to provide that Ameren Missouri shall file its reply brief no later than June 3, 2011.
