## **ORDER CORRECTING REPORT AND ORDER NUNC PRO TUNC**

On June 29, 2011, the Commission issued a report and order that became effective on July 9. That report and order was based on a stipulation of facts submitted by the parties. On July 11, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri, filed a motion asking the Commission to correct footnote 1 of that report and order. As Ameren Missouri indicates, the footnote incorrectly states that the recovery period at issue in the case ran from March 1, 2009 through May 31, 2009. In fact, that period represented the first accumulation period under Ameren Missouri's fuel adjustment clause. The recovery period in question ran from October 1, 2009 through September 30, 2010.

The Commission will correct the report and order nunc pro tunc.

### **THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Footnote 1 in the report and order issued on June 29, 2011, is corrected nunc pro tunc to state: "The Recovery Period in question ran from October 1, 2009 through September 30, 2010.

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
3. This case shall be closed.
