ORDER DIRECTING RESPONSES AND DIRECTING FILING

The Commission issued its Report and Order on May 4, 2011. Requests for clarification and rehearing were received on May 13, 2011. In addition, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (GMO) filed its tariffs in compliance with the Commission’s Report and Order on May 11, 2011, and also filed a motion for expedited treatment of those tariffs.¹ In addition, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and GMO filed a Second Nonunanimous Stipulation and Agreement Regarding Pensions and Other Post-Employment Benefits on May 13, 2011. The Commission shall set dates for responses to the settlement agreement and the other motions and applications for rehearing.

The Commission also directs GMO to explain in more detail and clarify (with citations to the record) its statement in paragraph 72 of its application for rehearing that, “GMO had proposed to provide 60 MW of capacity to the L&P district from MPS’s available capacity contract as well as the 41 MW of latan 2.” Further, the Staff of the Commission shall specifically respond to paragraph 72 of the GMO pleading and explain why or why not the capacity contract is not sufficient.

¹ GMO has also filed revised tariff sheets and a revised motion for expedited treatment on May 16, 2011.

Further, GMO, the Staff of the Commission, the Office of the Public Counsel, and Ag Processing, Inc., a Cooperative, shall address the legal authority of the Commission to require either GMO or Kansas City Power & Light Company to provide electricity to the L&P district at cost from their portion of Iatan 2 as a condition of approving the allocation of Iatan 2 as requested by GMO.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any objection to the Second Nonunanimous Stipulation and Agreement Regarding Pensions and Other Post-Employment Benefits shall be filed no later than May 20, 2011.

2. Any response to the Motion for Clarification and/or Reconsideration and Application for Rehearing of KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company shall be filed no later than May 20, 2011.

3. Any response to Dogwood Energy, LLC's Application for Rehearing shall be filed no later than May 20, 2011.

4. Any response to the motions requesting expedited approval of the tariff sheets shall be filed no later than May 20, 2011.

5. Any response to the Public Counsel's Application for Rehearing and the Application for Rehearing by Ag Processing Inc., a Cooperative, shall be filed no later than May 20, 2011.

6. Any response to the compliance tariffs filed by KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company on May 12, 2011, and the revisions filed on May 15, 2011, shall be filed no later than May 20, 2011.

7. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
