## ORDER SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On September 2, 2011, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company ("GMO") and the Staff of the Commission ("Staff") filed a Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement. On September 8, 2011, AG Processing, Inc., filed a timely Objection to Stipulation and Request for Hearing.

The Commission finds that a prehearing conference is now appropriate. The parties or their attorneys shall appear in person, or by telephone, at the conference. They shall be prepared to discuss the nature of any discovery each will conduct, the time necessary to complete discovery, and to prepare for hearing. Also, the parties shall be prepared to discuss the stipulation of facts not at issue. The parties will also be encouraged to discuss settlement.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. A prehearing conference shall be held on September 22, 2011, beginning at 10:00 a.m., in Room 305 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. That room is in a building that meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. Any person who needs additional

- 3. The parties shall jointly prepare and file a proposed procedural schedule or, in the alternative, each party shall file its own proposed procedural schedule, no later than September 29, 2011.
  - 4. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
