COME NOW Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren Missouri"), Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff" and "Commission," respectively), the Office of Public Counsel ("OPC"), Renew Missouri Advocates d/b/a Renew Missouri ("Renew Missouri"), Natural Resources Defense Council ("NRDC"), Midwest Energy Consumers Group ("MECG"), and Consumers Council of Missouri ("Consumers Council"), collectively, the "Parties," and jointly propose to amend the procedural schedule to allow a one week extension for briefing in order to determine if a settlement can be reached.
