#### ORDER SHORTENING TIME FOR RESPONSES

Issue Date: August 30, 2024 Effective Date: August 30, 2024

On July 30, 2024, The Empire District Electric Company d/b/a Liberty filed an application requesting a one-time variance to allow an industrial customer<sup>1</sup> to participate in Liberty's MEEIA programs for the current calendar year, 2024. That industrial customer previously opted out of MEEIA participation, and now seeks to revoke its opt-out.

On August 29, 2024, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed its recommendation. Staff recommended the Commission approve the application *so long as* the opt-out revocation applies to all of the customer's accounts in Liberty's territory.

As the application sought immediate eligibility for the customer, the Commission will shorten the time for responses to Staff's recommendation.<sup>2</sup>

#### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. No party is required to respond, but any response to Staff's recommendation shall be filed no later than September 6, 2024.
  - 2. This order shall be effective when issued.
