**ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE, SETTING INTERVENTION DEADLINE
AND DIRECTING STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

On December 31, 2013, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company ("GMO"), submitted an application containing its tenth true-up filing for its Fuel Adjustment Clause ("FAC"). GMO requests that the Commission authorize a true-up adjustment and implement it under its FAC tariff. The submitted tariff bears an effective date of March 1, 2014.

Pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-20.090(5), the Commission's Staff shall submit a recommendation regarding the proposed true-up no later than 30 days after its filing. No later than 60 days after receiving the proposed true-up, the Commission must: (1) issue an order deciding the true-up; or (2) suspend the timeline of the true-up to receive additional evidence or hold a hearing, if required. Consequently, the Commission shall issue notice, set an intervention deadline, and direct its Staff to file a recommendation.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3.161(10) provides that parties to the rate case in which the Commission established GMO's fuel adjustment clause are automatically parties to this tariff case, without the necessity of having to apply for intervention. Therefore, the Commission acknowledges that the parties to File No. ER-2012-0175 (the file in which GMO's FAC was most recently re-approved) are parties to this case, and will direct its Data Center to add those parties to the service list.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Data Center shall serve a copy of this order upon the parties to File No. ER-2012-0175.
2. The Commission's Data Center shall add all parties to File No. ER-2012-0175 to the service list for this case.
3. Any person or entity wishing to intervene shall file an application to intervene no later than January 20, 2014.
4. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file a recommendation regarding its examination and analysis of GMO's application no later than January 30, 2014.
5. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
