2 P R O C E E D I N G S

3 JUDGE STEARLEY: Good morning. Today is Tuesday,
4 March 5th, 2013. The Commission set this time for a
5 Procedural Conference in File No. EO-2013-0396, which is
6 captioned as In The Matter Of The Joint Application Of
7 Entergy Arkansas, Incorporated, Mid South Transco LLC,
8 Transmission Company Arkansas, LLC and ITC Midsouth LLC
9 For Approval Of Transfer Of Assets And Certificate Of
10 Convenience And Necessity, And Merger And, In Connection
11 Therewith, Certain Other Related Transactions.

12 My name is Harold Stearley, and I'm the Presiding
13 Officer of today's conference. We'll begin by taking
14 entries of appearance, starting with Entergy Arkansas.

15 MR. DORITY: Thank you, Judge. Larry DORITY with
16 Fischer & DORITY, P.C. Our address is 101 Madison Street,
17 Suite 400, Jefferson City, appearing on behalf of the
18 Joint Applicants Entergy Arkansas, Inc., Mid South TransCo
19 LLC, and Transmission Company Arkansas, LLC.

20 I have a written entry of appearance that I'll be
21 providing the Reporter. Thank you.

22 JUDGE STEARLEY: Thank you, Mr. DORITY.

23 For ITC Midsouth, LLC?

24 MR. LUMLEY: Good morning, Judge. Carl Lumley
25 with the Curtis Heinz Law Firm, with outside counsel for

1 applicant ITC Midsouth, LLC, and Brett Leopold of the
2 company, as well.

3 JUDGE STEARLEY: Okay. Thank you very much.
4 The Office of Public Counsel?

5 MR. MILLS: On behalf of the Office of Public
6 Counsel and the Public, my name is Lewis Mills. My
7 address is Post Office Box 2230, Jefferson City, Missouri,
8 65102.

9 JUDGE STEARLEY: Thank you, Mr. Mills.
10 And for the Staff of the Commission?

11 MR. DOTTHEIM: On behalf of the Staff of the
12 Missouri Public Service Commission, Steven Dottheim, Amy
13 Moore, Nathan Williams, Post Office Box 360, Jefferson
14 City, Missouri, 65102.

15 JUDGE STEARLEY: Thank you, Mr. Dottheim.
16 Can everyone on the phone hear us all right?

17 MR. STEINER: Everything so far.

18 JUDGE STEARLEY: I know I had sent a group email
19 to the parties and the applicants for intervention
20 yesterday saying I was going to take up the applications
21 for intervention at today's procedural conference, but I
22 had forgotten about a prior email where Entergy had
23 notified me that they wanted the full 10-day response
24 time.

25 So, really, response deadlines on the

1 applications, that are being coming up the 6th and 8th, I
2 believe, based on the filing. So, I am not going to take
3 those matters up today, but it's good that the applicants
4 are present so that, when we go off the record, they can
5 participate in the discussions amongst the parties.

6 Are there any preliminary matters we need to take
7 up at this time?

8 MR. DORITY: Not for us, Judge.

9 MR. DOTTHEIM: Well, Judge, in your order of
10 February 15th, you had in the order in Paragraph No. 9 had
11 -- or the Commission had directed that the Staff shall
12 investigate and file a report recommendation regarding the
13 application no later than May 15, 2013. The applicants
14 had requested, if I read correctly, Commission action by
15 May 2013, and the Staff -- and it didn't say May 1 or May
16 30, because they apparently were hoping to consummate the
17 transaction in June, and they had specified a date in
18 June. It was by June 30th.

19 And the Staff was -- was hoping to address, um,
20 this morning, um, with the applicants the May 2013 date,
21 whether that was May 1 or May 30, and also, to -- the
22 pending applications and the fact that -- that Entergy,
23 uh, uh, Arkansas may be ITC holdings in filing responses,
24 possibly we're going to take some position such as
25 opposition to the interventions, and the Staff wanted to

1 even take up what positions the possible interveners may
2 be taking in the case, whether a procedural schedule might
3 -- might be needed.

4 But given the fact that interventions haven't been
5 granted, I'm not sure how far we might be able to -- to
6 get this -- this morning. So, I'm really not sure what
7 the Staff is going to be able to propose until after the
8 filing that, apparently, is going to occur on March 7th.
9 So -- so, at the moment, the -- the -- the Staff might ask
10 you, Judge, you haven't explicitly asked for a status
11 report or anything further back from the Staff.

12 It's not that the Staff doesn't have other things
13 to do, such as other filing dates and what have you, but I
14 just might pose that question, uh, uh, for you, because
15 the Staff is -- is -- is mindful of -- of the pending
16 dates. And the Staff has certain individuals in the
17 hearing room this morning, and those -- not all the
18 individuals on the Staff who are assigned to this case are
19 in the hearing room, but they're basically the same
20 individuals who are assigned in general to transmission
21 matters, and they're assigned to some other pending
22 transmission cases that have hearings scheduled before the
23 Commission in April.

24 And, subsequently, so, the -- the Staff very much
25 has its eye or eyes on the dates which Entergy Arkansas

1 and ITC Holdings have put in its -- or in their joint
2 application, and whether -- if there are interveners in
3 this case, whether there might be or not for a hearing and
4 what that might do to the -- to the dates that are in that
5 joint application. So, I just -- I just thought that I
6 would say that to give you a heads-up, because that's
7 basically what I'm going to say when we go off the record.

8 JUDGE STEARLEY: All right. Well, you won't have
9 to repeat it now.

10 MR. DOTTHEIM: I hope I won't.

11 JUDGE STEARLEY: What I was going to do was ask
12 that you file a status report next Tuesday, the 12th.

13 MR. DOTTHEIM: Okay.

14 JUDGE STEARLEY: And you'll have an opportunity
15 then to discuss with the parties and, potentially, the
16 potential interveners as to how things might flesh out,
17 and you can all let me know how you want to proceed.

18 MR. DOTTHEIM: Okay.

19 MR. LUMLEY: We would hope, speaking for ITC --
20 I'm not speaking to the merits of anybody's applications
21 or anything -- but just in terms of respective of the
22 case, you know, we're talking about a hundred miles of
23 transmission lines that come out of Arkansas and serve a
24 few customers here on a wholesale basis, their assets that
25 the Staff went over pretty carefully very recently with an

1 Entergy application for certificate to resurrect a
2 certificate for the assets and to do some improvements to
3 the assets.

4 And, you know, ITC is a corporate family, is an
5 entity that the Commission's already approved as a holder
6 of assets in the northeast corner of the state, so it's
7 not a stranger to the state. So, we would just hope that
8 that perspective, you know, be maintained as trying to
9 sort out the issues that he was talking about.

10 MR. DORITY: And I would echo those comments, as
11 well, Judge.

12 JUDGE STEARLEY: Okay. Very good. Well, I'll
13 anticipate your status report on the 12th, then.

14 MR. DOTTHEIM: Okay.

15 JUDGE STEARLEY: Are there any other matters we
16 need to take up while we're on the record?

17 MR. DORITY: I don't believe so. Thank you.

18 JUDGE STEARLEY: All right. Off the record.

19 We're not off the record, not -- not yet.

20 MR. DOTTHEIM: Judge, might -- might I ask, if the
21 12th isn't a date of truly great significance, if I may,
22 if I might ask for offhand the -- maybe the 14th? And the
23 reason for that is in the two -- as I refer to them --
24 Transource cases, the EO -- excuse me -- EA-2013-0098 and
25 EO-2012-0367, on February 12th, we have scheduled a

1 settlement conference that day, and, um -- and I myself
2 have something scheduled that would take me out of the
3 office on the 13th. If it would not be --

4 JUDGE STEARLEY: Make it the 14th?

5 MR. MILLS: Can I make another suggestion?

6 JUDGE STEARLEY: Certainly.

7 MR. MILLS: How about five days or seven days
8 after the ruling on the applications to intervene.
9 Because, if there's not a response filed until towards the
10 end of this week and then the proposed interveners may
11 want a response to that, unless you're thinking that you
12 will have ruled on the applications to intervene by the
13 12th, assuming that just, you know -- because it's one of
14 two possibilities.

15 Assuming they were allowed in, we won't have had a
16 whole lot of opportunity to chat with them to figure out
17 where the case is going after knowing whether they're in
18 or out, if they are in. That may make the 12th or even
19 the 14th even a little premature to have a lot of
20 knowledge about how the case is going.

21 JUDGE STEARLEY: Well, let's see. The following
22 Monday is the 18th. Can we shoot for the 18th?

23 MR. DOTTHEIM: Yes, Judge, if that wouldn't be too
24 disruptive to your schedule.

25 JUDGE STEARLEY: It's not disruptive to me at all.

1 All right. I want to make sure everyone has an
2 opportunity for their responses and for some progressive
3 discussion.

4 Okay. All right. You can always tell me
5 something before the 18th.

6 MR. DOTTHEIM: Yes. Yes.

7 JUDGE STEARLEY: Anything else we should take up?

8 (No response.)

9 MR. DOTTHEIM: Not that I can think of, Judge.

10 JUDGE STEARLEY: All right. Very well. Now we're
11 off the record.

12 (Adjournment.)

13 (Whereupon, the record ended at 9:18 a.m.)
