2 (WHEREUPON, the prehearing conference
3 began at 11:00 a.m.)

4 JUDGE WOODRUFF: Welcome everyone to
5 the procedural conference in File No. EO-2014-0095,
6 which concerns Kansas City Power & Light Company's
7 filing for approval of demand-side programs and for
8 authority to establish a demand-side programs
9 investment mechanism.

10 We'll start today by taking entries
11 of appearance, beginning with KCP&L.

12 MR. FISCHER: Let the record reflect
13 the appearance of James M. Fischer, Fischer &
14 Dority, PC. Our address is 101 Madison Street,
15 Suite 400, Jefferson City, Missouri 65101.

16 JUDGE WOODRUFF: And for Staff.

17 MS. HERNANDEZ: Jennifer Hernandez
18 appearing on behalf of the Staff of the Missouri
19 Public Service Commission. I'll also enter the
20 appearance of Akayla Jones and Nathan Williams also
21 with the Staff Counsel's Office. Our address is

23 JUDGE WOODRUFF: Thank you. For
24 Public Counsel.

13 JUDGE WOODRUFF: For MIEC? Anyone

15 MR. WOODSMALL: Dave Woodsmall on
16 behalf of the Midwest Energy Consumers Group.

17 JUDGE WOODRUFF: I believe that's all
18 the parties.

19 MR. WEISKOPF: David Weiskopf from
20 NRDC is also on the line.

21 JUDGE WOODRUFF: Okay, David.
22 Mr. Weiskopf, do you want to enter your appearance?

23 MR. WEISKOPF: I'm having a little
24 bit of trouble hearing. Did you ask for an
25 address?

1 JUDGE WOODRUFF: Yes, please.

2 MR. WEISKOPF: 20 North Wacker, Suite
3 1600, Chicago, Illinois 60606.

4 JUDGE WOODRUFF: Okay. Anyone else
5 on the phone that I missed? Okay. And I believe
6 that's all the parties.

7 Well, that was probably the longest
8 part of this on-the-record portion of this
9 procedural conference anyway. And I just brought
10 you all together to discuss how we want to proceed
11 in this case, and as you're all very much aware,
12 I'm sure, we have a short time frame to act. We
13 have until May 7th. Whether we need a hearing or
14 not is up to you.

15 I'll give you a chance to discuss
16 amongst yourselves as to what kind of procedural
17 schedule you would like to reach to have the
18 Commission establish. Ask that you give me a
19 proposal by Monday, the 3rd of February.

20 And is there anything else anyone
21 wants to bring up while we're on the record?

22 MS. HERNANDEZ: If I might, may I ask
23 how much time the Commission is wanting before that
24 May 7th date to be able to deliberate and write the
25 Report and Order? Just because you mentioned the

1 schedule is so tight for everyone.

2 JUDGE WOODRUFF: Again, if we're
3 going to have to have a hearing, we need at least
4 30 days to write a decision. If you can reach some
5 sort of agreement, obviously we will need less
6 time.

7 MR. FISCHER: Judge, one of the
8 things that we'd thought about to try to get it
9 done in 120 days is to go with an initial brief and
10 not necessarily a reply brief.

11 JUDGE WOODRUFF: That would certainly
12 be acceptable. Again, it certainly works out
13 better if you can all reach an agreement, but of
14 course we're here to make a decision if that's what
15 we need to do.

16 MS. HERNANDEZ: Okay. Thank you.

17 JUDGE WOODRUFF: Anything else anyone
18 wants to bring up? All right. Then this
19 on-the-record portion of the conference is
20 adjourned, and I'll leave you to your discussions.
21 Thank you.

22 (WHEREUPON, the recorded portion of
23 the prehearing hearing was concluded at 11:04 a.m.)
