Okay. Well, there's not a 1 JUDGE BUSHMANN: lot to talk about today since the Staff and Companies and OPC 2 3 have already filed a proposed procedural schedule. 4 Do any parties object to the schedule that was 5 filed? 6 (No response.) 7 JUDGE BUSHMANN: I don't hear anything. 8 I think it looks pretty good. There was one 9 thing that I thought needed to be changed, a minor 10 modification, and that's about position statements. originally filed -- sent to be filed on August -- October 11 12 30th, which I believe is the Friday before the hearing starts 13 the following week. I've been told by Commissioners they 14 don't like that; and, so, the last couple of times that I've had this come up, they prefer to get position statements 15 16 prior to a week before the hearing starts. 17 So, it's my position we move that back from 18 October 30th back a couple days and have that filed October 19 28th, the same time the list of issues and other -- the order 20 of witnesses crossed and opening files. Anybody have any 21 problems with that proposal? 22 Judge, if I may, I would suggest MR. OPITZ: 23 that, in my experience, it's been difficult to have position 24 statements due the same day of list of issues. I guess I'm 25 looking at the surrebuttal is the day before, or the 27th,

1 and listed issues is the next day. 2 Would the 29th be, I guess, amenable to the 3 Commissioners, do you know? I would note that the 4 evidentiary hearing is not beginning on Monday, I don't 5 believe. I think it's on a Tuesday. 6 JUDGE BUSHMANN: Tuesday, right. 7 MR. OPITZ: So, that would be two days if we 8 had the 30th, and then that, I believe November 2nd. 9 JUDGE BUSHMANN: Yeah. That is a tight week, isn't it? Okay. Why don't we make that then the 29th. 10 11 MR. OPITZ: Okay. 12 JUDGE BUSHMANN: There is a lot going on. 13 Especially give them enough time to review it over the 14 weekend. 15 I didn't have any other changes. The rest of 16 it looks pretty good. Obviously, we don't have a lot of time 17 I'm sure the parties are well aware of that. 18 didn't have anything else that I needed to talk about. 19 Do any parties have anything that they need to 20 bring up? 21 MR. OPITZ: Judge, I guess I have maybe a 22 procedural question. Since they are two separate cases, 23 we've identified dates for each of them, and I can say from 24 my office I envisioned filing similar testimony but in each 25 docket.

Do you have any, I guess, preference as to how 1 2 the list of issues or position statements and all of the rest 3 of the briefs in these cases are handled? Do you believe 4 it's necessary to, you know, file position statements as if 5 they were two cases although we've got the hearing set for 6 the same date? 7 JUDGE BUSHMANN: Ri ght. My guess is these are 8 going to overlap predominantly. And, probably, the best 9 thing to do would be to file them together when you can and then point out clearly where there might be a difference 10 11 between the two companies. And that way you don't have to --12 and you can make it one document with two headings if you 13 want, the same, one for each of the cases. That will cut 14 down on document preparation, and then try -- try and do them together to the extent possible, but just make it clear when 15 16 there is a difference, that that shows up. 17 MR. OPITZ: Thank you. 18 JUDGE BUSHMANN: If that clarifies things. 19 Anybody else have anything that they need to 20 talk about? 21 (No response.) 22 JUDGE BUSHMANN: All right. Hearing none 23 then, I will go off the record, and you all have the phone until 4. 24 25 (Record was closed at 2:09 p.m.)
