2	JUDGE JORDAN: The Commission is calling the
3	action in File No. EO-2018-0079. This is the
4	Application Of Edith Armstrong For Change Of Electric
5	Supplier From Empire District Electric Company To Ozark
6	Electric Cooperative.
7	My name is Daniel Jordan. I'm the Regulatory
8	Law Judge assigned to this action, and we are here for a
9	prehearing conference. I will start by taking entries
10	of appearance, and please, I will ask counsel to
11	introduce any client representatives. Let's start with
12	Ms. Armstrong. Will you introduce yourself, please?
13	MS. ARMSTRONG: My name is Edith Armstrong.
14	JUDGE JORDAN: And with you you have someone
15	joining you on the line?
16	MS. ARMSTRONG: No, it's just me and my sister
17	here.
18	JUDGE JORDAN: Okay. And can you give us your
19	sister's name?
20	MS. MURR: Hello.
21	JUDGE JORDAN: Hello. Is this Ms. Armstrong's
22	sister?
23	MS. MURR: Yes, it is.
24	JUDGE JORDAN: Can you state your name for the
25	record, please? Page

1	MS. MURR: Mary Frances Murr.
2	JUDGE JORDAN: Thank you, Ms. Murr. Will you
3	spell Murr for me?
4	MS. MURR: M-u-r-r.
5	JUDGE JORDAN: Thank you very much. And for
6	the Empire District Electric Company?
7	MS. CARTER: Diana Carter with Brydon,
8	Swearengen & England, 312 East Capitol Avenue, Jefferson
9	City, Missouri.
10	JUDGE JORDAN: Thank you. Ms. Carter, do you
11	have anyone else with you today?
12	MS. CARTER: No, I do not.
13	JUDGE JORDAN: Okay. Thank you. For the
14	co-op Ozark Electric Cooperative?
15	MR. BATTAGLER: Yes. Shawn Battagler with the
16	Andereck Evans Law Firm in Springfield, Missouri.
17	JUDGE JORDAN: Thank you, Mr. Battagler. Is
18	anyone else joining you from your client?
19	MR. BATTAGLER: No.
20	JUDGE JORDAN: Okay. Thank you. Staff of the
21	Public Service Commission?
22	MS. MERS: Nicole Mers, Steve Dottheim and Ron
23	Irving on behalf of the Public Service Commission, and
24	our information has been provided to the court reporter.
25	JUDGE JORDAN: Thank you. And you have a Page

1 couple representatives of your client? MS. MERS: Yes. On behalf of staff we have 2 Dan Beck and Noumvi Ghomsi. 3 JUDGE JORDAN: Thank you. Was there anything 4 5 else, Ms. Mers? MS. MERS: That's the technical staff assigned 6 7 to this case. Thank you. JUDGE JORDAN: Very good. Thank you. 8 9 also call for any appearance by the Office of Public 10 Counsel since our regulations make them a party to every 11 action before the Commission. But not seeing nor hearing any representative, I will conclude that they 12 13 have elected their option not to appear in this action. 14 So this conference is in part on the record, 15 that's this part that we've done. We can discuss 16 procedure and substantive matters and settlement 17 options; but once that's done, once you've dispensed 18 with the need for a regulatory law judge and the court reporter, the rest of your time can be spent off the 19 20 record in this room and with this telephone line. I 21 believe we have it for an hour. When we're done, I will ask staff to lock up and turn off the lights. 22 23 I will remind the parties that mediation is 24 also possible if they're not able to work out the 25 differences amongst themselves. And I suggest that if Page

1 the parties do not resolve their differences, more than a suggestion, I will ask staff to report to me no later 2 3 than the end of the day tomorrow how this conference went. And if matters are not resolved, then we will be 4 looking for a proposed procedural schedule. 5 MS. SCOTT: Excuse me for interrupting. I've 6 7 been sent to the wrong hearing, I believe. Is this a Children's Division? 8 JUDGE JORDAN: This is not the Children's 9 10 Division. MS. SCOTT: Okay. I've been sent to the wrong 11 12 meeting. I apologize. I'm breaking off now, Kerry 13 Scott. Thank you. 14 JUDGE JORDAN: Okay. Good luck. All right. Well, that being said, any 15 16 questions by the parties? 17 MS. MERS: Ms. Armstrong, I believe that you 18 and staff had discussed your desire to go forward with 19 the case. Do you have any statements that you'd like to 20 make to the judge or to the parties regarding that? 21 MS. ARMSTRONG: No. I got my electricity turned back on, and I would like for it to stay like it 22 23 There's no way I can pay \$12,000 to get it switched is. 24 over. 25 MS. MERS: And so you're wanting to dismiss Page

1	the case then, correct?
2	MS. ARMSTRONG: Yes, dismiss it.
3	JUDGE JORDAN: Okay. Well, dismissal is
4	pretty easy for an action at the Public Service
5	Commission. All the Commission would need to see would
6	be a writing dismissing the case. It's really just a
7	notice. It's not even a motion. If I recall correctly,
8	there's been no testimony filed in this action. Am I
9	right about that? I'll ask staff.
10	MS. MERS: There's only been a staff report
11	but no testimony.
12	JUDGE JORDAN: Okay. Well, that's pretty
13	simple, and that may take care of this action if that's
14	all that you want to do. While I'm here, is there
15	anything else that I can help the parties with?
16	MS. ARMSTRONG: No.
17	MS. MERS: Just to clarify, Judge, would you
18	like Ms. Armstrong to send you something in writing, a
19	letter, just to make clear what we've talked about
20	today?
21	JUDGE JORDAN: That's correct, Counselor.
22	What I'm talking about is what we call in our
23	regulations a notice of dismissal, and all that is is a
24	writing, a letter format would do, delivered to the
25	Commission that says that the complainant, or the Page

1	applicant in this case Edith Armstrong, dismisses her
2	action. That dismissal will be effective as soon as the
3	Commission receives it.
4	The Commission doesn't even have to do
5	anything. It's automatic.
6	MS. ARMSTRONG: Okay. Now, where do I send
7	that to?
8	JUDGE JORDAN: You send that to the Missouri
9	Public Service Commission, and you probably have our
10	address on some of the stuff that we've sent you.
11	MS. ARMSTRONG: Jeff City?
12	JUDGE JORDAN: That's correct.
13	MS. ARMSTRONG: Okay. P.O. Box 360, Jeff
14	City, Missouri?
15	JUDGE JORDAN: That's the one.
16	MS. ARMSTRONG: Okay. I can do that.
17	JUDGE JORDAN: It will help if you put your
18	file number on it, that is the EO-2018-0079 number.
19	MS. ARMSTRONG: Okay. File No. EO-2018-0079?
20	JUDGE JORDAN: That is the file number.
21	MS. ARMSTRONG: Okay.
22	JUDGE JORDAN: All right. Anything else I can
23	do for the parties while we're altogether in one room
24	with me and the reporter? I'll ask Ms. Armstrong,
25	anything? Page

1	MS. ARMSTRONG: No, that's it.
2	JUDGE JORDAN: How about for the company?
3	MS. CARTER: Nothing for me. Thanks, Judge.
4	JUDGE JORDAN: For the cooperative?
5	MR. BATTAGLER: Nothing more for me.
6	JUDGE JORDAN: Anything from staff?
7	MS. MERS: No, thank you.
8	JUDGE JORDAN: All right. Well, that sounds
9	like it concludes the on-the-record portion of this
10	conference. With that, we will adjourn the conference
11	and we will go off the record. Thank you, everyone.
