MOTION FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT AND FOR APPROVAL OF TARIFF FILING ON LESS THAN THIRTY DAYS NOTICE

Comes now The Empire District Electric Company ("Empire") pursuant to 4 CSR

240-2.065 and 4 CSR 240-2.080(16) and in support of its Motion For Expedited

Treatment And For Approval Of Tariff Filing On Less Than Thirty Days Notice ("Motion")

respectfully states as follows to the Missouri Public Service Commission

("Commission"):

- 1. On November 14, 2002, the Commission issued its Report and Order in the captioned-matter in which it approved, among other things, the Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement which had been executed by the parties to this case. By said Report and Order, the Commission directed Empire to file tariffs in compliance with the Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement.
- 2. Contemporaneously with the filing of this Motion, Empire has filed compliance tariffs with the Commission. The tariff sheets bear an issuance date of November 15, 2002 and an effective date of December 15, 2002.
- 3. The Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement approved by the Commission provides in part that the Commission should authorize Empire to file tariff sheets in

conformance with the Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement, said tariff sheets to become effective December 1, 2002. This provision is contained in the Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement because the parties recognized that from Empire's standpoint the December 1, 2002, effective date was a key inducement to enter into the Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement.

- 4. As indicated, the Commission, by its Report and Order, approved said
 Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement and directed Empire to file as soon as
 practicable proposed tariff sheets in compliance with the agreement. Said Report and
 Order further provided that the proposed tariff sheets could have a thirty day effective
 date and be accompanied by a motion requesting expedited treatment. By this Motion,
 Empire is complying with that directive and respectfully requests that the Commission
 issue its order approving the tariffs filed by Empire this date for service rendered on and
 after December 1, 2002.
- 5. Empire submits that there is good cause for granting its request and that the subject tariffs should be permitted to go into effect on December 1, 2002. As indicated, such an effective date is consistent with the terms of the Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement approved by the Commission in this case in which the parties recommended that the tariffs be implemented effective for service rendered on and after December 1, 2002. Second, from Empire's standpoint, implementation of the tariffs by December 1, 2002 was a key inducement to enter into the Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement. Third, pursuant to §393.140(11), RSMo the Commission may by order, allow a change in rates on less than thirty days notice in any event. In

the case at bar, the Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement, approved by the Commission, specifically provided in paragraph 5 that the Commission by its order approving the agreement, should allow Empire to file tariff sheets to become effective less than thirty (30) days from the filing date.

6. Empire has filed the subject tariff sheets and this Motion with the Commission as soon as possible after the issuance of the Commission's Report and Order in this docket approving the Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement. Since the subject tariff sheets will implement the terms of the Stipulation and Agreement, which the Commission has determined to be just and reasonable, there can be no harm to Empire's customers if said tariffs are implemented in accordance with the effective date recommended by the parties.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, Empire respectfully moves the Commission to give expedited treatment to Empire's tariff filing and to this Motion and to issue its order approving the subject tariffs on less than thirty (30) days notice and authorizing said tariffs to become effective for service rendered on and after December 1, 2002, good cause having been shown.
