JOINT MOTION TO AMEND PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

COME NOW Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren Missouri"), Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff" and "Commission," respectively), the Office of Public Counsel ("OPC"), Renew Missouri Advocates d/b/a Renew Missouri ("Renew Missouri"), Natural Resources Defense Council ("NRDC"), and Midwest Energy Consumers Group ("MECG"), 1 collectively, the "Parties," and jointly propose to amend the procedural schedule to allow a one week extension for briefing in order to determine if a settlement can be reached.

- 1. On July 26, 2024, the hearings concluded in this matter and initial briefs were due on August 21, 2024. At the August 7, 2024, agenda session, the Commission suggested a path forward in this docket and based on the Commission feedback, the Parties have scheduled meetings to determine whether a settlement can be accomplished.
- 2. Accordingly, the Parties agreed to discuss the potential of a settlement and after some discussions, determined additional time is needed. The Parties respectfully request the schedule be amended to allow initial briefs to be filed on October 16, 2024, and reply briefs to be filed on October 30, 2024.

WHEREFORE, the Signatories to this pleading respectfully request the Commission adopt the amended procedural schedule to allow the parties to discuss a possible settlement.
